The following additional condition is recommended:

- 1. The defendant shall participate in mental health treatment services as directed by the probation officer until successfully discharged. These services may include medications prescribed by a licensed physician. The defendant shall contribute to the costs of services rendered (copayment) at a rate of at least \$20 per month.
- 2. The defendant shall not illegally re-enter the United States, if deported, removed, or allowed voluntary departure.
- 3. As a condition of supervised release, upon completion of his term of imprisonment, the defendant is to be surrendered to a duly-authorized immigration official for deportation in accordance with the established procedures provided by the Immigration and Naturalization Act, 8 USC §§ 1101 et seq. In the event the defendant is not deported immediately upon release from imprisonment, he shall also comply with the standard conditions recommended by the U.S. Sentencing Commission.
