9	COUNT 1
10	From on or about December 17, 1997, until the present, the exact dates are unknown, in the
11	District of Arizona, and other places, known and unknown to the Grand Jury, SAMIH FADL
12	JAMAL, TAMER FAYEZ SWAILEM, MARWAN FADL JAMAL, ABDULRAZZAK FADL
13	JAMAL, RAMY FADL JAMAL, MAMOUN AL-JAMAL, WALID FADL JAMAL, HANI
14	JAMAL SARAWAN, SAAD TOMA YOHANAN, ABDUL KHADER KHALED HAMZE,
15	AHMAD MY ALHULAISI, KAHLED AHMAD NOAMAN, AHMED MOHAMED ASHRY,

21	defendants herein, conspired and agreed with other persons known and unknown to the Grand
22	Jury, to commit offenses against the United States, that is, the receipt and transportation in
23	interstate commerce of goods, that is, cases of infant formula, valued at more that \$5,000, which
24	goods were then known to them to be stolen, including within the meaning of 18 U.S.C. § 21, in
	violation of Title 18, United States Code Sections 2314 and 2315.
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OBJECTS OF THE CONSPIRACY

It was an object of the conspiracy that the defendants and their co-conspirators profit
 by: 1) purchasing stolen and/or fraudulently obtained infant formula; and 2) reselling said infant
 formula to food wholesale and retail outlets at a competitive price.

5 2. It is further the object of the conspiracy that the JAMAL organization transports, 6 distributes and sells stolen, repackaged infant formula in interstate commerce to various retail 7 WIC ("Women, Infants and Children") stores and wholesale businesses. The organization also 8 sells stolen cans of infant formula through three WIC retail stores known as Arizona Nutrition 9 Inc., which are owned and operated by SAMIH JAMAL. All of these activities were committed 10 to make a profit.

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MANNER, MEANS, AND METHODS

The defendants engaged in purchasing, receiving, repackaging, and distributing infant
 formula obtained via theft and fraud in interstate commerce.

As part of the business, the defendants acquired infant formula in interstate commerce
from individuals and suppliers who obtain the infant formula throughout the United States via
theft and fraud. These individuals typically acquired individual cans of infant formula from large
retail stores, and transported the infant formula to the JAMAL TRADING COMPANY.

After the stolen infant formula was repackaged at the JAMAL TRADING COMPANY
 warehouse, the JAMAL organization transported, distributed and sold the infant formula in
 interstate commerce to various retail and wholesale businesses.

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OVERT ACTS IN FURTHERANCE OF THE CONSPIRACY

8 Grocery Store, 5127 W. Indian School Rd, Phoenix, Arizona.

9 7. At or about April, 2000, Samih Fadl Jamal opened an American Express Corporate 10 credit card account 3715-3135-55-01003 in the name of Samih Jammal/Jammal Trading 11 Company.

8. On July 14, 2000, a relative and employee of Sharif Kader Hamdan's purchased
represented stolen infant formula from an undercover officer at the Ballpark Quickstop, 1025 N.
7th Street.

9. On August 8, 2000, Sharif Kader Hamdan agreed to purchase stolen infant formula from
an Undercover Officer.

17 10. On August 26, 2000, Rami M. Awwad and Laura Michelle Early, utilizing a white 2000
18 Chevrolet van Illinois license 2086-XE registered to Laura M. Early, shoplifted infant formula
19 from Walmart, 2300 Sycamore Rd, Dekalb, Illinois.

11. At or about October, 2000, Samih Fadl Jamal added Abdul R. Jamal, AKA Abdulrazzak
Fadl Jamal as an authorized user for the Jamal Trading Company American Express corporate
credit card account.

23 12. On or about November, 2000, Samih Fadl Jamal added Marwan Fadl Jamal as an
24 authorized user for the Jamal Trading Company American Express corporate credit card account.

13. On January 19, 2001, Samih Fadl Jamal completed a Federal Food Stamp Application
for Stores, Form FCS-252, for the purpose of obtaining authorization for the Arizona Nutrition
Store #1, 4419 E. Main St, Suite 107, Mesa, Arizona, to distribute infant formula through the

1 WIC program.

14. On or about January 30, 2001, Samih Fadl Jamal and Tamer Fayez Swailem commenced
doing business as Arizona Nutrition Store #1, 4419 E. Main St, Suite 107, Mesa, Arizona.

4 15. On February 1, 2001, Ramy Fadl Jamal applied for and received a Garden Grove,
5 California, city business license for the R J Grocery Trading, 12821 Western Ave., Suite E,
6 Garden Grove, California.

7 16. On February 12, 2001, Marwan Fadl Jamal changed universal price code "UPC" labels
8 on cans of infant formula to fraudulently obtain the formula at a reduced price at Walmart, 2450
9 W. Loop 338, Odessa, Texas.

10 17. On May 19, 2001, Abdul Khader Hamze, shoplifted infant formula from Walmart, in
11 Greensboro, North Carolina.

12 18. On May 29, 2001, Samih Fadl Jamal co-signed a lease application for the Sonoran
13 Ridge Apartments, apt. #123, 1205 E. Apache Blvd, Tempe, Arizona, for Khaled Ahmad Noaman
14 and Alaa Ghassoub Obeid.

15 19. On June 1,2001, Marwan Fadl Jamal shoplifted infant formula from Wal-Mart, 401 E.
16 Highway 82, Sherman, Texas.

On June 5, 2001, Khaled Ahmad Noaman and Walid Jamal obtained infant formula by
fraud at Walmart, 4517 North Midland Drive, Midland, Texas, through the utilization of a
competitor price match scheme.

20 21. On August 3, 2001, Mohamed Anis Hemdani and Mounir Midani Daly shoplifted in fant
21 formula at the Albertson's grocery store in Lake Oswego, Oregon.

22 22. On August 8, 2001, Kamel Al-Fadheli shoplifted infant formula at the K-Mart store,
23 4225 W. Indian School Road, Phoenix, Arizona.

24 23. On October 2, 2001, Samih Fadl Jamal and Ahmad Ashry transported infant formula.
25 24. On October 12, 2001, Marwan Fadl Jamal attempted to obtain infant formula by fraud
26 by utilizing a competitor's price match scheme at the the Wal-Mart, in Sulphur Springs, Texas.
27 25. On November 14, 2001, Samih Fadl Jamal co-signed the lease for apartment #2077 of
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the Sun River Apartments, 505 W. Baseline Road, Tempe, Arizona, for Khaled Noaman and
 Abdulrazzak Jamal.

26. On December 4, 2001, Salvadore Valladores, an employee of Ramy Jamal and the RJ

21 infant formula from Henry Contreras at Tex-Mex Trading, in Houston, Texas.

22 59. On May 29, 2002, Slimane Hamzaoui transported infant formula.

60. On May 31, 2002, Tamer Fayez Swailem paid an undercover detective \$20,500.00 in
cash, the balance due, for the the represented stolen infant formula purchased on May 15, 2002.

of the value of \$5,000.00 or more, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §
2314; receipt, possession, concealment, storage, selling, and
disposing of stolen property of the value of \$5,000,00 or more that

has moved interstate after being stolen, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §

2315.
