

THE FOLLOWING IS A TRANSCRIPTION of a recorded telephone call between MAZEN AL-SAIEGH and CHAWKI HAMMOUD, which occurred on March 10, 1998. Portions of Hammoud's conversation were in Arabic, not transcribed.

S/A BOB MALEK: It's March 10<sup>th</sup>, 1998. It's approximately 12:05 PM. I'm going to make a call to Charlotte, North Carolina, Area Code 704/532-8275. IN Number is 745301-97-0032.

CHAWKI:	Doral from here, pick them up, eight twenty-five.

CHAWKI:	Eight-two-seven-five.	
MAZEN:	That's the same last numbers as this one?	
CHAWKI:	Yeah.	
MAZEN:	Okay. What's the area code, 704?	
CHAWKI:	Right.	
MAZEN:	Okay. Okay, uh –	
CHAWKI:	Also, I mean, you have to give some time because this guy doesn't always, ah, I mean, if you can give two or three days because we get two thousand a week from the guy, you know what I mean?	
MAZEN:	Yeah.	
CHAWKI:	So we'll try to get all of it	
MAZEN:	Okay. So you mean sometime?	
CHAWKI:	People rush him, a lot of people go to him and quickly [buy] it from him.	
MAZEN:	Yeah, yeah.	
CHAWKI:	So it's not like he has it in stock all the time, so for example if I go to him now he wouldn't have any goods. He get these things on specials.	
MAZEN:	Okay. No problem. Okay, I'm gonna call you next week.	
CHAWKI:	Okay.	
MAZEN:	And, uh –	
CHAWKI:	Give some time, a few days, if you know when you're coming, and we'll put [the order] together before you get here.	
MAZEN:	O – okay, no problem.	

CHAWKI:	Alright.
MAZEN:	Okay, cousin.
CHAWKI:	Peace.
MAZEN:	Thanks. Bye-bye.
(Disconnect)
