- MF And peace be upon you and God's mercy and His blessings.
- KJ May God grant you long life, Zabeehullah!
- MF How's it going, my brother.
- KJ May God keep you.
- MF How's your health?
- KJ What's new with you?
- MF Praise be to God. How ...
- KJ Abu Zurr is surely with us [on the line].
- KD [Reciting poetry] "Here I come, willing to be poor for the sake of God and Religion"
- KJ [Laughs].
- KD Absolutely!
- KJ [Laughs].
- MF How are you doing, my brother?
- KJ Great! [pause] may I, just one moment.
- KD No, no, not a single moment.
- KJ [Laughs] Just a second, one moment.
- KJ [Now speaking to JC believed to be in the room with him] Sorry Jeremy, this is Canada.
- JC <u>I'll just ... I'll just give you a call tomorrow.</u>
- KJ O.K., I'm very sorry. I kept going back and forth.
- JC <u>No problem!</u>

- MF Did he eat?
- KD Yea Mohammed, he's been eating a lot, a lot. (UI) is his health O.K.?
- MF <u>Yea</u>, and I just saw him at my [paternal] uncle's house [can also be father in law]. He looked fine, by God. He talked to my [maternal] aunt (UI), wow ...
- KD He talked to her?
- MF Umm ... uh ... <u>I think</u> the ... uh ... is starting to act ...
- KD How did you find him?
- MF Find him? He's getting better.
- KD Huh?
- MF He's getting better (SC) (UI).
- KD (SC) Isn't it so, Mohammed?
- MF (SC) His speech is improving.

- KJ I told him to have Abu Mohammed talk to her [beep is overheard] ... you see ...
- KD Uh huh ...
- KJ ... about not interfering in matters other than those for which she is responsible, I mean. I mean, her responsibility is to have the news come to her, as per our agreement, all news should come to her. And we've agreed that, I mean, the work will be better this way. And ... uh ... should she happen to hear about other things, and so on ... that's it! she shouldn't

get involved, I mean, with other matters ...

- KJ Huh?
- KD Your brother Abu Sayyaf and I talked to her today.
- KJ Yes.
- KD Uh ... and we said words ... I mean we told her ... my brother, they ... it seems that the [Muslim] Brothers over there are annoying her a great deal, I mean. We told her "if you're going to waste your time with this, I mean ... I mean a lot of time ... a lot of time is going to be wasted."
- KJ Yes.
- KD I mean a lot, a lot, a lot of time is going to be wasted. And I mean ... but I mean we told her ... I mean ... I mean we set her straight by the grace of Almighty God.
- KJ Alright, may God reward you. I mean it is very important ... I told all this to Abu Abdul Rahman ...
- KD Yes.
- KJ ... because she might want someone she trusts ...
- KD Yes.
- KJ ... so I mean I told him to tell her husband to talk to her ... so ... of course he ... I mean he will be more ... he will explain to her exactly what she should do.
- KD Uh ... did her husband get to the inside, or is he still in that area?
- KJ No, he's still there.
- KD Huh?
- KJ They have responsibilities, my brother. There still are responsibilities on the outside.
- KD Yea.

They have been instructed to stay outside.

Yea?

- KJ Yes.
- KD And how about inside? What did he tell you about inside?
- KJ Inside ... I mean, praise be to God ... but ... uh ... I mean even the news reaches them intermittently, I mean.
- KD Yea, so what ... what ... I mean what did he tell you?
- KJ By God, my brother ... uh ... I mean, everything he told me was that the roads are cut off, that the Russians are deployed everywhere in Dagestan. So right now, they are now looking for different ways. I mean, you're talking about a situation that has just occurred Abu Zurr ... the Russians have entered Shattoy (PH) two days ago ... I mean the last village.

- KJ Shattoy? Yea, they took it. But my brother, I mean you are talking about ... I mean I call it a hollow victory.

- KJ [Chuckles] Abu Zurr, the telephone calls haven't stopped. This Abu Sayyaf ... Abu Sayyaf is going to chop off my head, my brother ...
- KD [Laughs].
- KJ ... I promised Abu Sayyaf the <u>fax</u> like two hours ago ... [laughs] ... but ... uh ... whatever God wishes [God bless!]. Did you get "Al-Ansar"? [Islamic publication].
- KD What?
- KJ Did you get "Al-Ansar"?
- KD No my brother. Did you get it?
- KJ I got "Al Ansar", yes.
- KD [Sarcasm] Hide it!
- KJ And it has a commu ... [Laughs] ... Just give me a chance. It has two communiques that you're not going to like. It has a communique that shocked me, frankly ... and the sheikh was annoyed by it. But God willing, it's all good.
- KD God Willing, for the best.
- KJ God Willing, it's all good.
- MF <u>O.K.</u>, my brother.
- KJ So ...
- KD It's the afternoon ... it's the afternoon prayers, hold on ...
- MF O.K. (UI).
- KJ [Laughs] It's already the afternoon.
- KD My brother ...



- KD Uh ... what did I want to tell you? ... we spoke ... I mean we spoke to the sister today ...
- KJ Yes ...
- KD ... and we told her ... I mean ... I mean ... my brother ... my brother ... by God, I mean she began to cry ... my brother, the [Muslim] Brothers over there are driving her crazy ... [leaving] messages and who knows what ... every day ... every day ... every day ...
- KJ Glory be to God.
- KD So we told her "that's it ... those ... no ... don't give them <u>any information</u> ... nothing ... "how are things?" "things are O.K.", that's it ... right or not, my kind brother?
- KJ She's not supposed to give <u>information</u> to the [Muslim] Brothers. The <u>information</u> she receives, as per our agreement, gets to Abu Abdullah, and gets to <u>Benevolence</u> <u>International</u>, brother Suleiman, and to <u>C.A.R.E.</u> Those are [the recipients] we agreed upon. And of course, to you, [plural], to Abu-Sayyaf and to us over here. So, I mean what is she? Does she send them the news?
- KD I ... I believe she used to, but now, I mean after we ...
- KJ Oh my God!
- KD ... after we spoke to her today ...
- KJ O.K. ...
- KD Uh ...
- KJ ... I will, God Willing, confirm this with her ... my brother these are blood merchants ...
- KD (SC) My brother ...
- KJ (SC) ... may God's curse be upon them.
- KD (SC) (UI) I mean ... I mean ... that's it ... we don't want to keep on coddling her ... that's it ... we already talked to her ... I mean, <u>everything it's clear now (sic)</u>.
- KJ Alright, <u>O.K.</u> They are attacking us over here. They're trying to prevent us from collecting donations.



My brother, if we ... by God, my brother ... they are a headache. Today, one of them called me in the morning ... today ... he's someone I know, he's my friend, from over there, from Lebanon. He was telling me "Al Halbawi ..." I told him "damned be Al Halbawi ... you're still ... you're still hounding me with this Al Halbawi, even over here ... "

- KJ [Laughs].
- KD He told me "he [Al Halbawi] was talking and he began to cry". I told him "and what if he cried? I told him "whom was he talking about?" He said "he was talking about Al Nah'nah!" I told him "who gives a damn?"
- KJ What? Whom was he talking about?
- KD About Al Nah'nah, and he started to cry ... and he said ... he said that Al Nah'nah is a Mujahid.
- KJ Sufficient is God and He is the disposer of affairs.
- KD I told him "this guy is an apostate, man!" ...
- KJ Do you know ... do you know what's Al Nah'nah's current position is now?
- KD (UI).
- KJ Al Nah'nah is in the interim government formed by Zerwal (PH). Al Nah'nah is the only Muslim in this government ... a Muslim by name only ... all others, in fact, have declared war on Islam. He is the only one who espoused Islam.
- KD Glory be to God.
- KJ And he was interviewed many times, my brother ... and oh my God ... by God, my brother [quoting] "launch war against the Infidels and the Hypocrites and treat them ruthlessly ... "
- KD Yes.
- KJ "... You must treat them ruthlessly ... you must ..." Sheikh Salman Al-'Auda (PH) says "He, who forsakes Jihad against the hypocrites commits a sin." There is the jihad of the word by publicly exposing them. Sheikh Salman says "A way to launch jihad against the hypocrites is to expose them!" So someone like Al Nah'nah must be exposed.

Laughs] But I told him ... I told him ... I told him words ... at the end ... at the end, when I was done, he said "watch out, your line is wiretapped." [Laughs] I told him "Bring it on!" Are you listening?

- KJ God forbid!
- KD He said "Your line is wiretapped." I said "Do you think I'm scared that my line is wiretapped?" [Laughs].
- KJ [Laughs].
- KD [Laughing] I really gave to him ... to him .. and to Al Nah'nah ... Al Halbawi is coming over here, huh?
- KJ Umm! Where is he coming to?
- KD He's coming over here, to Edmunton.
- KJ Is that possible?
- KD Yea, by God Almighty.
- KJ By God, my brother, <u>you have to, at least</u> ... uh ... carry a small <u>sign</u> for him ... carry a <u>sign</u> for him.
- KD By God, my brother, <u>I don't have time for this stuff</u>, I have no time because this guy is a phony. (UI) this is all phony.
- KJ Yes.
- KD This guy is a phony, my brother. I don't have time for him. If they all ... unfortunately ... unfortunately ... all his followers over here ... all of them are college students.
- KJ In fact, it doesn't matter, my brother, because the collection is going to be minimal ...
- KD (SC) (UI) <u>professionals</u>, and not one of them ... their hearts have not opened up their minds to the truth. Praise be to God, we ... we have nothing.
- KJ Yes.
- KD Glory be to God. Glory be to God.



May God damn them, my brother ... by God, my brother, these people come from the lowest stratum of hell, believe me, by God.

- KD By God, my brother, God only knows what will happen, God only knows! ... there's some news about the ... uh ... in Egypt.
- KJ Yes.
- KD Uh ... the brothers have taken down eight.
- KJ In the South?
- KD Eight from ... from the Mukhabarat [Egyptian intelligence].
- KJ Where?
- KD By God, I don't know where exactly.
- KJ This is a big operation, by God!
- KD It's a big, big operation ... eight Mukhabarat [Egyptian intelligence services] ... spies.
- KJ Yes.
- KD Eight! Did you know that one of the high ranking brothers, I mean died as a martyr? His name is Bashir, if you ... if you've heard of him.
- KJ I haven't heard this news, no.
- KD Yes, he's one of ... one of the honorable brothers. Him ... him ... him ... and ... and his group. I mean they surrounded them, but, God bless! This brother used to wear ... he used to wear ... uh ... I mean this is what they wrote in the <u>fax</u> that ... that I received ... about the strike ... I mean this news concerns them ...
- KJ Yes.
- KD ... anyway, I will send it to you in the mail God willing, on Monday, God Willing!
- KJ Yes, may God reward you.
- KD With Almighty God's permission ... I mean maybe you can make <u>copies</u> and give them out, God Almighty willing.



- KJ With God's permission.
- KD With Almighty God's permission! He used to wear ... uh ... I mean monk's clothes ... and go practice Da'awa [propagate Islam] in ... in the towns and ... and the cities.
- KJ Umm ...
- KD I mean, he was one of ... one of ... one of the brothers who ... God bless him ... God bless him ... God bless him ... he was amazing. Anyway, my brother, we ask Almighty God for steadfastness.
- KJ Amen, O Lord, Amen.
- KD And how did you say the sheikh was doing?
- KJ The sheikh, praise be to God. He is in high spirits. And I mean the trial is starting to come to a close. Within a month, maybe ... they might start concluding within a month.
- KD God Willing!
- KJ The matter might require a month.
- KD God Willing, lord of all worlds. My brother, we want ... we want news about the situation in Chechnya on the inside, my brother ... I mean, there's none ... there's none.
- KJ Wasn't the report enough for you?
- KD Huh?
- KJ Wasn't the report enough for you?
- KD My brother this ... my brother this ... my brother this report ... there's nothing in this report, my brother ... we want the situation ... the current situation ... right now ...
- KJ What do you want with the situation ... they got to Shatoy, and all the Mujahideen are up in the mountains. They have reached Shatoy, and the Mujahideen are all over the roads. I mean, they're saying that if they have reached Shatoy, it doesn't mean that it's over. Do you have a map or no?



- KD No my brother, I don't have a map.
- KJ Just take a look at it, my brother, I mean Shatoy lies pretty much in the Central [area], not in the South. They draw it as being in the South.
- KD Uh ... did you (UI) the ... uh ...
- KJ Do you know how far Shatoy (PH) is from Grozny?
- KD How far?
- KJ Fifty kilometers.
- KD O.K., regarding ... regarding the hospital ...
- KJ What about the hospital?
- KD Uh ... according to the BBC ...
- KJ Yes.
- KD When I listened to the BBC at four o'clock over here.
- KJ Yes.
- KD They're saying that some of the mujahideen came out of the hospital and were caught in a battle with ... with the ... the Russian forces outside the hospital.
- KJ This is correct.
- KD (UI) Because I mean, they filmed them ... they filmed them ...
- KJ Yes.
- KD ... I mean they filmed the battle...
- KJ Yes.
- KD ... the battle outside the hospital.



- KJ Correct.
- KD They ... at first they said there were forty, but they were actually eighty ...
- KJ The Mujahideen?
- KD Yes, there are eighty of them.
- KJ There are a hundred mujahideen. Approximately a hundred men.
- KD (SC) (UI) They said forty ... and then sixty ... and I mean now it's eighty.
- KJ I mean the ... the brothers said that there are approximately a hundred men. What actually happened is that after their victory over the base, they split up ... the majority of the group left and withdrew ...
- KD (SC) Uh ...
- KJ ... they withdrew to different locations.
- KD But what is written here in a newspaper called "Globe and Mail" ...
- KJ Umm ...
- KD ... is that they were going to Moscow. But that the policeman who allowed them to go into this city ... [Chuckles] ... they didn't have <u>enough</u> money to pay him ... to get to Moscow with what they had.
- KJ Glory be to God.
- KD Yes, this was in the "Globe and Mail" newspaper.
- KJ Allahu Akbar! [God is the greatest!]
- KD I mean they got to the inside in connivance with the Russian policeman.
- KJ Yes.
- KD I mean, they gave him money in order for him to let them get in like that.



- KJ Yes, yes.
- KD (SC) And it said that they didn't have <u>enough</u> money to pay him in order to ... in order to get to Moscow.
- KJ (UI) O.K., my brother, what did they want to do in Moscow?
- KD They wanted to take the parliament.
- KJ Yes
- KD I mean, this ... this [would have been] ... Allahu Akbar! [God is the greatest!], huh?
- KJ Allahu Akbar! [God is the greatest!].
- KD I mean they wanted to go into the Russian parliament.
- KJ I have just heard on CNN that they have agreed to a cease fire in Chechnya and that they are starting negotiations for the withdrawal of the Russian Army. Look at the lies!
- KD And the news we heard about ... did you ... did you see Boris Yeltsin on ... on the thing?
- KJ May God damn him!
- KD Did you see him? Did you see him?
- KJ I saw him. He said "Those who wear the black head dress around their heads ..."
- KD Yea?
- KJ "... these are <u>terrorists</u>, they are savages, they should be killed!"
- KD But he was ... he was shaking.
- KJ Yes, of course, he is ... he is going to die from all the alcohol that's in his blood. He's an <u>alcoholic</u>. He's addicted to alcohol. He's a slave to alcohol.
- KD Anyway ... [sighs] ah ... ah ... ah ...



- KJ What my brother? God willing, that's it! It's over ... that's it, Russia is finished! Abu Zurr, sheikh Shamil defeated Russia and the tsarist [regime] and its artillery and everything, with only his swords ... thirty years.
- KD And this Shamil ... the one who's on the inside now, his name is also Shamil.
- KJ The who's name is Shamil and who's on the inside now, came from Abkhazia.
- KD <u>Oh! Oh!</u>
- KJ Yes.
- KD So he must be Abkhazian then.
- KJ No, he's not Abkhazian, he's a Chechen, who used to fight Jihad in ... in Abkhazia.
- KD Allahu Akbar! [God is the greatest!].
- KJ So when the war started ...
- KD Yea?
- KJ All the Abkhazian Mujahideen left the George ... the Georgians ... and the Mujahideen of Azerbaijan left the Armenians and said "these are not our enemies" They said "our real enemies are up there ... the Russians ... " so that's why they withdrew ...
- KD [Interrupts] My brother ... uh ... there's another matter.
- KJ Yes.
- KD There are some Christians from Lithuania and Estonia ...
- KJ Yes ...
- KD ... who are fighting along with Muslims.
- KJ This is true. This is true. They are mostly Catholics.
- KD Correct.



- KJ And I mean those have suffered the most ... and these people used to live in harmony ...
- KD [Interrupts] No, the reason ...
- KJ ... with the Muslims during the time the Muslims were in the horn.
- KD They ... no. no... there is only one reason why they came to fight Jihad with the Muslims.
- KJ Umm ...
- KD The reason is that when Dudayev was asked to hit Lithuania and Estonia ...
- KJ He refused.
- KD He refused.
- KJ Yes.
- KD So, now they are paying, I mean like they say, they're paying him.
- KJ Yea, but there are major ideological differences between the Russians and the Lithuanians. I mean these two countries in particular. Because the Russians butchered them. Do you remember the <u>deportation</u> they carried out against the Ingush and the Chechens? Do you remember?
- KD Huh?
- KJ When they expelled a million of them, and they deported them ... they deported them to Kazakhstan and to Siberia.
- KD Uh huh ...
- KJ Within this same [wave of] <u>deportation</u>, Stalin dragged along the Estonians and the Lithuanians. Why? Because he accused them of connivance with the Germans. Therefore, my brother, all these people hold a grudge against them.
- KD But, I mean, the truth is my brother, that I ... Hikmatyar's [followers] who are in Azerbaijan are still ... not very many of them went in on the inside, my brother.



- KJ Why? <u>Oh.</u> of course, not all of them. I'm not saying that they all did. But some of them went up ... I mean, the brother Ibn al-Khattab, who was on the inside ...
- KD Yea ...
- KJ ... he sent this news.

[Pause].

- MF Peace be upon you.
- KJ And peace be on you and God's mercy and His blessings.
- KD So, I mean Ibn al-Khattab ... I mean ... I mean he did confirm that there are Afghans on the inside?
- KJ Of course, my brother, of course ... <u>of course</u>. Right now, my brother, there are people from everywhere, from everywhere [sighs and clears his throat].

[Pause].

- KD My brother, is this Ibn al-Khattab, an Arab or ...?
- KJ Yes.
- KD Huh?
- KJ Yes. It seems he is either Palestinian, or Jordanian or Chechen. I mean one of the three. I mean I talked to him.
- KD Huh?
- KJ I talked to him.
- KD Is he on the inside or on the outside?



KJ He goes in and goes out ... he comes and he goes.

[Pause].

- KD Since you've read the latest news ... his group ... I mean it <u>sounded</u> like he is the one who was in the latest battles.
- KJ Uh ... Shamil?
- KD No, the other one, Ibn al Khattab
- KJ Yea, I mean you know, his group is with the sheikh ... sheikh Fathi.
- KD Yes.
- KJ Yea, God willing all will be well, my brother ... God willing all will be well. But the main thing is I mean, my brothers, I wish we would try to become more active in the matter of donations.
- KD My brother, what we want from you my brother, just let our brother Abu Abdul Rahman ... talk to him ...
- KJ Umm ...
- KD ... let him get on the inside, my brother ... my brother let him see how the situation is on the inside ... I mean let him give it his full attention first hand ... and my brother, let him come to us, my brother ... my brother we will take him around my brother and we will tour with him, my brother
- KJ Bu Zurr! <u>O.K.</u>, let's work with what's in our hands. If he ... my brother, suppose that Almighty God rewards him with martyrdom ...
- KD (UI).

[Pause].



- KJ Zabihullah?
- MF Yes.
- KJ Abu Zurr wants to wait for Abu Abdul Rahman.[Laughs].
- MF From the inside.
- KJ O.K., but if he ... he has all the information ...
- KD Peace be upon you.
- KJ And peace be upon you and God's mercy. Abu Zurr, you have all the information. Just get out and start giving sermons to people ... talk to people.
- KD What?
- KJ Talk to people, there's nothing to it.
- KD We already talked my brother ... and those who are with us my brother ... my brother we (UI).
- KJ This is not what I mean, this is not what I mean. I mean the other <u>community</u> where you intend to go around with Abu Abdul Rahman ... <u>it's O.K.</u>, it's very good ... but let's not wait until Abu Abdul Rahman gets here.
- KD (UI) God forbid, <u>no, no, no</u>, my brother<u>, no</u> ... my brother I ... that's not what I meant, my brother.
- KJ Umm ...
- KD What I mean ... what I mean ... my brother ... I mean, our area, where we live, my brother, over here, yes, we're doing our job here. But my friend, we are forbidden to collect donations in three mosques, we are forbidden.
- KJ l understand, l understand.
- KD When it comes to mosques, you may cross us out ... and Zabeehullah over here knows.



- MF Absolutely, Absolutely (SC) (UI).
- KJ (SC) Anyway ...
- KD (SC) Not over here, not in Calgary and not in any area ... my brother, over here, in all of Alberta ...
- KJ Yes ...
- KD ... in all of Alberta my kind brother, all the mosques are with the [Muslim] Brothers, my brother.
- KJ Sufficient is God and He is the disposer of affairs.
- KD You cannot ... over here, my brother, in all of Alberta, we ... we ... Alberta, which is the size of Lebanon, sheikh ... we are forbidden to collect a single penny.
- KJ Yes.
- KD Except from those trustworthy people that we know.
- KJ Yes.
- MF Absolutely not ... absolutely not ... God forbid ...
- KD My brother ... for us ... for us ... the source is South America. This is our source.
- KJ Yes. Let me tell you, Abu Zurr. Yesterday, I went over to <u>Riverside</u>, <u>O.K.?</u> which is a small city nearby ... I mean there is not a single fact that I hear that I don't write down, you know ... I mean news about Chechnya. How they act, what happened with Abu Omar, and so on and so forth ... I tell people all these things. And we show them the video and we explain to them what's in the video. People were very moved, my brother.
- KD My brother, but my brother ... people allowed you to do so ... but my brother, we are forbidden!
- KJ No, you don't understand me. I understand you.[Chuckles].
- MF <u>They boycott it</u>, brother Kifah!



KJ So, you mean to tell me, if Abu Abdul Rahman goes over there, they would allow him?

KD What?

- KJ If Abdul Rahman ... Abu Abdul Rahman goes over there, they would allow him?
- KD No, my brother ... over here, my brother, in Canada my brother, they won't allow him here.
- KJ I understand.
- KD I was speaking of South America, my brother.
- KJ O.K., so why don't you go to South America.
- KD (SC) (UI).
- KJ You have ... just a moment, Abu Zurr ...
- KD Yes.
- KJ Abu Zurr, you speak Mexican, uh ... I mean you speak Spanish, right?
- KD (UI) Yes, my brother, we have brothers over there, my brother, who know more about the people who are over there, my brother.
- KJ Umm ...
- KD Yea, my brother, just yesterday, we spoke to a brother, I mean he's a brother ... a brother ... I mean over there, God Bless him, my brother ...
- KJ Umm ...
- KD ... he just asked on his own. He just asked on his own ... (UI) he said "my brother, we want someone from the inside over there, my brother, to come to us over here ... why my brother?
 from the beginning my brother, they've had <u>experience</u>, my brother ... they gave people.
- KJ O.K. I have ... I have an idea, Abu Zurr. Abu Zurr, I have an idea. Do you have time? go



to Baku for a week and then get back to the brother, and I'll give you the airfare.

- KD My brother ... my brother ...
- KJ My brother, Abu Abdul Rahman is asking for money now. <u>He wants</u> money. <u>O.K.</u>? He needs this money ... he won't be able to leave the location where he's at in order to come and get it.
- KD Of course.
- KJ So, if there's an opportunity in ... in South America to bring in this money, screw the two thousand dollars which is the cost of a ticket.
- KD My brother ... my brother now ... I am over here my brother ... my brother (UI) I have a problem my brother ... my mother came ...
- KJ I understand, but I ...
- KD (SC) (UI) September, God willing.
- KJ What?
- KD I cannot leave before September.
- KJ Go down for one week, if you can ... just one week, <u>O.K.</u>? Go down to Istanbul for one day, say hello to our brother over there, and then go spend the rest of the time in Baku ... all the brothers are there ... you will become one hundred percent acquainted with the situation over there. <u>O.K.</u>?
- KD I'm thinking to see what (UI).
- KJ Go, get inside the borders, and do whatever you want, <u>whatever</u>, and then come back ... not more than a week. Then you will go to South America and get ... <u>you have to</u> <u>mobilize</u>.
- KD That's true.
- KJ Because when Abu Abdul Rahman gets over here ... I actually don't know whether he will come right away. I could tell from his words, when I talked to him, that he has no



intention to come.. But if and when he gets over here, it would be <u>too late</u> regarding the money. Our brothers are under tremendous pressure right now. I spoke to him today, he asked me and insisted on the money issue.

- KD My brother, we ... we ... yesterday, I mean we sent to our sister ...
- KJ No, no, I understand but I'm talking about opportunities that are awaiting. What, Abu Zurr? Do you think that I'm questioning the work that you [plural] do? [Laughs].
- KD No, God forbid, my brother. God Almighty forbid, my brother. But my brother, now my brother, I mean regarding what you said ... if I could, by God, I would leave right now.
- KJ Abu Zurr, you have the <u>Spanish language</u>, none of us does. Abu Omar, God have mercy on him had this thing. Right now, there's only you ... there's only you. Abu Abdul Rahman doesn't speak any <u>Spanish</u>. And ... and this would be a fact-finding mission. You just go and come back.
- MF [speaking to KD] Rely on God then for one week.
- KJ <u>It's one week</u>. And by the way, the people are ready to pay for the tickets, my brother. There are people who have been telling us now Find someone, and we'll pay for the ticket. <u>O.K.</u>? So, you give us the name of the <u>travel agency</u> after you make the reservation, and I'll have them transfer them the check from here. So, this is regarding South America. So ...
- MF (UI) which mean <u>you need a week</u> over there, my brother, and I mean another week in South America, which means <u>two weeks</u>.

[Telephone ringing].

- KJ <u>Two weeks</u>, You can come back, and spend a week with the family ... may I, one moment?
- KJ [Answers the phone] Peace be upon you! Hello Nasser! Can I ... are you at home?
- KJ So we should rely on God.



- KJ [Still on the other phone] O.K. so let me call you <u>back</u>. Peace be upon you! [goes back to KD and MF] I'm sorry Abu Zurr!
- MF Just go ahead and go!
- KJ Abu Zurr!
- KD Yea.
- KJ Uh ... look this suggestion is a little weird of course, it's not my suggestion or anything. But what I mean is that if the brothers over there are insisting ...
- KD (SC) That's it my brother ... uh ... (UI) God willing.
- KJ ... look, let me tell you something ... if the brothers insist on someone who just came back from over there ... I advise you ... my advice is that you should go ... get there ... talk to the brothers over there and get acquainted with the situation first-hand, and then come back here. But if the brothers, and I am certain of this, trust you, <u>O.K.?</u> And they trust that you will present them with the unquestionable facts. You have all the information, my brother ... you have a <u>video</u> filmed by the Mujahideen, not a documentary video. We have here a Turkish video filmed by the Mujahideen at the battle of Grozny. And there are some <u>videos</u> that are coming to us on Monday. They've all been filmed on the inside recently, I mean. Battles of the plains and the mountains. And you have the latest news and we have the reports that you could present to the people over there, and you also possess the <u>Spanish language</u>. Go down there for a week right now, for example, take two weeks to plan for the journey, go to South America and let's get this thing done with.
- KD All will be well, God Willing, my brother. Let me think about the ... the matter.
- KJ Yea, and try to speak with the brother over there.
- KD I was just telling our brother Zabeehullah, I was telling him that I ... I can't leave before ... before September. This is the problem. So until then, I mean it's too late.
- TH Three months.
- KD I mean three months.
- KJ Even to South America.



- KD Yea, this story, I mean ... my brother ... we were set up to go before now my brother, but the brother who ... Who ... I mean <u>our right hand</u> over there, was away in Hong Kong. And he went to Lebanon and he was late coming back here ...
- KJ Yes.
- KD ... so I mean, he was late, and he also got us to be late, I mean that dear brother of ours, may God bless him. So right now ... I mean right now ... I cannot leave before <u>September</u>.
- KJ Yes.
- KD But I mean this trip to Baku, is a must.
- KJ [Sighs] By God, Abu Zurr ... <u>yea</u>... God willing ... we have to ... we have to get everything in motion ... the people in South America should understand ... they should understand that all the brothers over there are busy ... that we cannot just pull someone from there to come to talk to them or <u>whatever</u>. But we are going to get them someone who has full knowledge of what's going on. As would a Mujahid see it all with his own eyes, this brother will have the same view; He has the information which got in by <u>fax</u> ... he has the <u>video</u> ... and ... and he has the trust ... because he is a part of these mujahideen. This means that this person who is coming to you is not someone who sits behind a desk, and that's it ... no, this is an individual who supports the ongoing work over there. So I mean I hope you will talk to them, because this is a glorious opportunity that cannot be replaced.
- KD Absolutely, my brother, absolutely, absolutely.
- KJ Why I am saying this? Because my brother, their situation is <u>critical</u> right now. Their situation right now is that they are in dire need. So maybe after a while ...
- KD [Interrupts] Let us talk to ... to the brother one more time and see what he ... I mean what he advises us ...
- KJ By God, my brother, I wish I could speak Spanish ...
- KD What?
- KJ ... if I spoke <u>Spanish</u> ... <u>Spanish language</u> ... I would go and get in touch with him and try to convince him in whatever. And also, Abu Zurr, we can prepare the <u>material</u> that you



want We'll get you maps, you can show maps, we'll prepare a video for you ... whatever.

- KD All will be well, God willing. Let us ... my brother let us talk to our brother over there, and get in touch with him.
- KJ Yes. How many mosques are there over there?
- KD What?
- KJ How many mosques?
- KD There's a mosque in Panama ...
- KJ (SC) Good.
- KD ... City ... and a mosque in Maicao (PH) ... in Colombia.
- KJ How far away is it by plane?
- KD Uh ... about an hour and some, and then about five hours on the road.
- KJ Good. These are two mosques. And the third?
- KD The will be in San Andres, but that one ... that one ... our brother is in the old country. He isn't there ... our brother who's [usually] there.
- KJ O.K., Good. So you have two that you could cover in one weekend. A promotion of your visit will be for a Friday ... announcing a speech or a lecture on a Friday ... fund raiser ... and the second one would be on a Saturday and you could get back here on a Sunday, God Willing. One weekend. And whatever ... look whatever you collect ... whatever this trip will cost, it will be covered, God willing. But at least, we would have spread the news. I am certain that [the people] in South America, right now ... they have no news at all, except for what they get from you.
- KD That's it ... yes ... that's true.
- KJ That's it. Has the video reached them or not?



- KD I believe I sent it over, by God, I do not recall whether I sent it or not.
- KJ Yea, the video tapes that we should be receiving on Monday will all be new. So, you go ahead and think ...
- KD This ... I mean my brother, send them over to us immediately, may God keep you.
- KJ Right away. As soon as ... I won't even convert them. They might be in PAL. I will send them to you the way they are.
- KD All will be well, God willing.
- KJ Yea, but Abu Zurr, I mean, <u>please think about it</u>. Forget about a week. Go down for <u>one</u> <u>weekend</u> ... <u>one</u>, two, three straight. It might be a long trip for you, but, it's O.K., let's try, my brother ... let's knock on this door.
- KD O.K., all will be well, God willing.
- KJ Yes
- KD All will be well, God willing. Let's first ask for our brother's opinion over there.
- KJ Good! And when you're ready, tell me, for the ticket, God willing.
- KD God Almighty willing!
- KJ <u>O.K.?</u>
- KD O.K., my kind friend.
- KJ O.K., may God reward you. Peace be upon you!

"End of conversation."
