On or about December 24, 1998, in the Southern District of 9 California, the defendant AL-MOHDAR MOHAMED AL-MOHDAR ZEID, aka Mohdar 10 Mohamed Abdullah, did knowingly present to the Immigration and 11 Naturalization Service an application required under the immigration 12 laws, and regulations prescribed thereunder, to wit, an application 13 for asylum and withholding of removal [Form I-589], which contained 14 || a statement, to wit, that he last entered the United States without 15 inspection on December 7, 1998, through New York, New York; which the 16 defendant then and there knew was false, in that in truth and in fact 17 he entered the United States on December 10, 1998, from Canada, on a 18 Yemeni passport with a valid United States B-2 visitor's visa; in 19 violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1546(a). 20

<u>Count 3</u>

On or about February 23, 1999, in the Southern District of California, in a matter within the jurisdiction of Immigration and Naturalization Service, an agency of the United States, defendant AL-MOHDAR MOHAMED AL-MOHDAR ZEID, aka Mohdar Mohamed Abdullah, did knowingly and willfully make and caused to be made a false, fictitious, and fraudulent material statement and representation, to wit, that he last entered the United States without inspection on

December 7, 1998, through New York, New York, on an Italian passport;
which the defendant then and there knew was false, in that in truth
and in fact he entered the United States on December 10, 1998, from
Canada, on a Yemeni passport with a valid United States B-2 visitor's
visa; in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1001.

## Count 4

7 On or about May 5, 2000, in the Southern District of California, 8 the defendant AL-MOHDAR MOHAMED AL-MOHDAR ZEID, aka Mohdar Mohamed Abdullah, did knowingly present to the Immigration and Naturalization 9 Service an application required under the immigration laws, and 10 regulations prescribed thereunder, to wit, an Application to Register 11 as a Permanent Resident [INS Form I-485], which contained a statement, 12 13 to wit, that he last entered the United States without inspection on December 7, 1998; which the defendant then and there knew was false, 14 in that in truth and in fact he entered the United States on 15 December 10, 1998, from Canada, on a Yemeni passport with a valid 16 United States B-2 visitor's visa; in violation of Title 18, United 17 States Code, Section 1546(a). 18
